Articulation Rules:

- 1. Any EIGHTH note on a DOWNBEAT will be SMOOTH ("DOO")*
- 2. Any QUARTER note on an UPBEAT will be SHORT ("DAHT")*
- 3. Any EIGHTH note on an UPBEAT will be ACCENTED ("DAH")*

unless otherwise marked

In a Mellow Tone Melodic Line = "Dee-Day-Doo-Dit-Dah"

Arranging Idea:

- 1. Have TRUMPET section play what is written (MELODY)
- 2. Have SAXOPHONE section echo the melody (COUNTER-MELODY)
- 3. Have TROMBONE section play what is written (MELODY)
 - Also common to incorporate a background in the trombone section (voice leading w/ smooth notes or pops w/ shorter notes)
- 4. Have RHYTHM section comp (FOUNDATIONAL SUPPORT)

Any other ideas on how we can arrange this melody?

Changing Melodic Rhythm:

- Call and Response with just the first two measures!

Changing Style:

- Works well in a Bossa-Nova Style (Straight-Eighth Feel)
